Great news! Capstone has signed a letter of intent with Hope Baptist Church to sell 15 acres of our 75 acres to build their new campus. Representatives of Hope are excited about our vision to give Las Vegas students a world class education to develop them into the next generations leaders. There is discussion of sharing use of the new building and/or parking.

BUILDING RELATIONSHIPS... SUMMER GATHERING

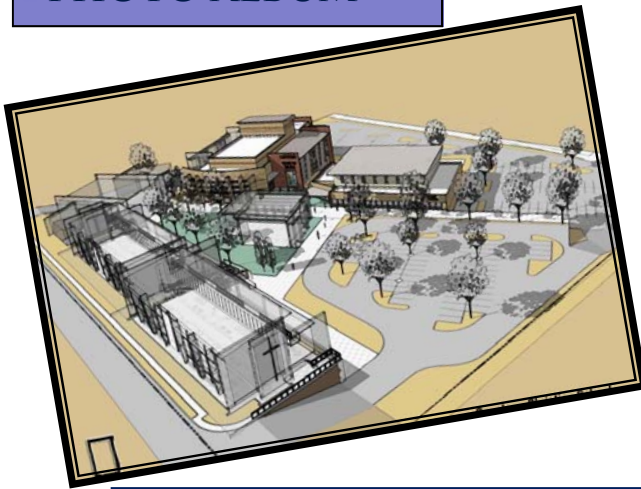
